

Correspondence up to the 31st May 2019

1. An update from the PCSO:
 - a. Parents are starting to park on the yellow lines outside the School in the afternoons. The PCSO will look into this over the next few weeks.
 - b. More reports about dangerous parking on the junction of Spring Lane with the High Street. One vehicle was traced and words of advice given.
 - c. Speed checks in Shrub Lane on the 28/05.

3. Offer from John Harmer to come and update on Rights of Way
Council Decision Required in reply to Mr Harmer's offer.
4. **Resident's query re access to the Beart car park:** The Clerk reports that the owners of the property were very helpful. They said they were unaware that the agreement was to put a hedge back and they are happy to do so. They will plant a mixed hedge in November, as that is the best time for planting.

The owners reported that the gate is for emergencies only and is locked and never used. They were advised to put one in for disabled access as, in the event of the lane being blocked, there is no other emergency access. The access parallel to the carpark down to the high street has been blocked off.
