- 1) Re-surfacing of the High Street from 28/08/18.
- 2) Blocked path at Burwash Common. (Letter from resident) RDC has looked into the matter but as of 07/08/18 waste at the site had not been removed. The Clerk has requested that a date be given for the removal.
- 3) Problem with Manhole cover on High Street (Request from Residents) ESCC has confirmed this will be dealt with as part of scheduled re-surfacing. Residents are requesting a back-up letter from Burwash PC to Southern Water.
