Subject	Handyperson Job list from w/c 26/11/15

Proposed Handyperson jobs from w/c 26/11/18 – Please note that completion of these jobs will be weather dependent:

1. Replace the three memorial benches – Each iron bench needs to be carefully cut off at the base and the new wooden benches to be concreted in
2. Burwash Map needs to have the top cover removed – currently the top is cemented into place but bugs and dirt has got in over the years. The cover needs removing the tiles cleaning and the top replacing and then properly resealed
3. Do a cut of the grass along the High Street in between the lime trees etc from Ham Lane down to Vine House.

Grit Bin Review

Laurence has done a full report on all the grit bins in the Parish. His recommendations are:

Summary

In general most of the pipes are difficult to see/locate. Consideration should be given to them being painted to improve visibility. This is now weather dependent. Below are the identified grit bins/pipes which require work:

1. Shrub Lane – Junction A265 Bin – There appears to be no prepared base and the bin is in danger of slipping into the road or toppling over. In view of the relatively busy junction advise that a proper level concrete base be provided as high priority.
3. Spring Lane – 50m from A265. Pipe. Vegetation should be cut back.
6. Spring Lane – Northwest of Southover. Vegetation should be cut back
11. Willingford Lane – adjacent Hedge Nest. Pipe. Needs to be filled.
12. Willingford Lane – 100m south Hedge Nest. Pipe broken by vehicles pulling in to passing bay. Pipe should be replaced, relocated and filled.
16. Kings Hill – Opposite Kemland Cottage. (next to elec. pole) Pipe. Vegetation should be cut back.
17. Kings Hill – 50m north of Parkwood car park. Pipe. Needs to be filled. Vegetation should be cut back.

Resolution

Cllrs to resolve for the above works to be carried out using this current list as the order of priority.
