

## **COMMUNITY KNITTING PROJECT**

After the success of the poppy knitting project last year, I have been asked to find out if this could be repeated.

Friday 8th May 2020 will be a bank holiday to celebrate the end of WWII and 75 years of peace in Europe [cue a sub-committee to prepare for celebratory community events?]

If BPC is minded, we could knit/crochet red, white and blue triangles to make bunting. This could then be reused for the Burwash fair if BPFA interested.

I have done some research and the best price I have found has been £1.40 for 100gram balls of acrylic yarn and I think we will need 10 balls of each colour, therefore £42 [which includes postage].

I am happy to lead this project and have two volunteers already to help with both the organising and production plus 4 others, so far, willing to knit and crochet.

If the council is happy for me to go ahead with this would they please approve the expenditure of £42 to facilitate this, if funds are available.
