

Additional lights at Christmas

Peter, at Noakes Cottage, has suggested that we might put up additional lights in the High Street, and had canvassed householders whose permission we might need for fixings to their houses. An estimated length of lighting and costs were provided.

I asked Councillors for their views, and those that responded thought it a good idea, although made the point that Matthew, who is responsible for the present lights, should be involved in the installation of anything additional.

I am also aware that the only provision in the budget is for the replacement of existing lights should this be necessary.

May I suggest that, if replacement lights are not needed, then this amount could be used to provide additional lights from the west end of the present run, to Revenue Cottage, providing that Michael is able to carry out the work as close to the turning on of the other lights as possible.

The Council should then discuss allocating funding for additional lights for December 2000.

I have copied this to all councillors, Sylvie, Rachel, Michael and Peter at Noakes Cottage.

I am happy to co-ordinate this if it is something we agree to pursue.
