Semi-detached houses and flats:

The houses and flats in the main Ashwood site are designed to have a traditional appearance with materials and massing which fit comfortably into the styles of building nearby, using pitched roof forms.

The appearance of the flats and semi-detached houses are sympathetic to the principles set out in the **High Weald Housing Design Guide** and use materials and construction features which are included in the Guide.

They have materials which suit the area, being a combination of brick, render, weatherboarding, white windows and clay tile roofs. The weatherboarding is in a series of soft colours, which assist in giving the scheme visual variety and a comfortable appearance.
