



Telecommunications & Energy Supplier Review

Telephone Landline & Wifi.

Current Provider BT for Landline & Broadband wifi.

- Billed quarterly
- May 13th 2020 = £215.00 – for 3 months
- August 13th 2020 = £155.36 – for 3 months
- Equates to £51.78 per month based on last bill
- Going to increase as parish offices open and usage increases
- Would have balance to pay on leaving dependent on when this happens

Proposed alternative: XLN Business Communication

- Billed monthly on direct debit
 - Business only provider
 - Award winning customer service
 - Quoted £19.95 per month (without unlimited calls)
 - Quoted £24.95 per month (including unlimited calls)
 - £50 credit on account when signing up. Credit due to Clerk using this company for another business. For clarity, the £50 credit would apply to both business accounts
 - This would be for a 24 month contract

Energy Supplier.

Current provider EDF Energy.

- Currently £243.17 in credit on the account
- Monthly direct debit £31.00
- Tarriff = Fixed for Business to March 2021
- Contract ends March 2021
- Currently pay 15.25p per kw
- Currently pay 25p per day as a standing charge
- Direct debit discount of 7% on total bill

Proposed alternatives researched.

- Learnt through research that switch sites work differently with business energy accounts. All based on call backs and not on online quotes like residential switch services
 - Bulb – currently only offer business accounts to limited companies and charities
 - Quotemyenergy.com – Comparison site call back on 20-08-20
 - Recommended the following services:
 - EON
14.89p per kw
31p per day standing charge
Fixed for 24 months

- Opus Energy – 100% renewable energy supplier
14.52p per kw
30p per day standing charge
Fixed for 24 months

Both companies would save approximately £110 – 120 per annually.
