Draft Minutes of the Traffic and Transport Working Party held virtually by Zoom on Monday 1st February 2021 at 7pm.

1. Apologies for Absence.

Apologies were received from Lesley Moore and Steve Moore.

2. Disclosures of Interest.

There were none.

3. Minutes from the previous meeting held on 14th January 2021.

The minutes of the last meeting were agreed.

4. Burwash Common & Weald 20mph Feasibility Assessment.

Lyndsay reported that following discussions with Mr. Vaks, it had been agreed that the application for the change in speed limit would only be submitted for the top section of Stonegate Road, between the A265 and the Spring Lane junctions with a single survey point by the Church. It was also agreed that the Vicarage Road survey would proceed. Council is asked to resolve to pay for the speed surveys at £410 approximately each.

5. Cycle/Footpath submission to Etchingam Station update.

Steve Moore gave a written report stating that he had rung the Officer involved at ESCC and left messages on his answering machine but has not had a response.

6. Village Gates Design.

It was agreed that the submissions and prizes would be decided by this Committee. However the Committee would not necessarily use the winning entries, but may ultimately choose a combination of suggestions for the final sign.

7. Car Park and Electric Charging Points Update.

The Lease is being pursued at the highest level within Rother but to date nothing has been received. It was agreed that a small working party led by Steve Moore would present their suggestions for the operation of the Car Park to this Committee.

8. SLR Meeting.

At present there was no firm date for the SLR meeting and members were asked to contribute any items for discussion. Two particular problems were raised for inclusion at the meeting – bad road repairs and badly designed road profiles.
