Summary

The next Love Burwash will be on the 23rd March. The Clerk has been engaging different organisations and people to raise awareness of the date. The Parish Clerk has been in contact with:

1. Burwash Brownies/Guides and Beavers/Scouts – dates have been submitted to leaders. Safe places have been identified for the younger volunteers to work on:
 - a. Burwash Swan Meadow – to wash down the playground equipment (please note there is a private function on at Burwash Common Pavilion so volunteers cannot do the same there but may be able to do litter picking away from the Pavilion).
 - b. St Philips and St Barts Church yards to do a general clean-up of leaves and pathways
2. Burwash Common and Weald Residents Association – Their support and assistance has greatly appreciated especially getting residents engaged. This time the Clerk will ask that an individual Cllr will support the Weald and Common areas. They have been hugely helpful in providing key areas that need focus on.
3. The Churches – they are happy to promote the day and there are no major events on this day for them.
