

BURWASH PARISH COUNCIL

Draft Minutes of the Traffic and Transport Working Party held virtually by Zoom on Monday 6th December 2021 at 6pm.

2. Disclosures of Interest.

3. Minutes from the previous meeting held on 8th November 2021.

4. Feedback from Burwash Common & Weald Site Visit with Peter Heasman (Project Manager, ESCC – Costain).

- c. As BCWRA had conducted a survey of the residents in 2018/19, this would form part of the Consultation stage.
